## **Paper Bag Book Report due= November 7, 2018**

After completing your novel you will review what you read while completing a paper bag book report.

On the front of the paper bag you will:

A. Draw a neat and colorful scene from your novel (*you will explain this during your presentation*)

B. Include the title and author of the novel

C. Your full name and class period

On the back of the bag you will write a plot line for your novel. Be sure to include all parts of the plot line and a total of at least **10 events**. (*The exposition counts as one event and consists of the main characters, the setting, and the initial conflict*)

\*\*\*Remember to use complete sentences.\*\*\*

Inside the bag you will need to place at least **8 objects** that represent significant events in the novel or aspects of the characters' personalities. *Sometimes students create notecards for each object to make the presentation easier. I always recommend practicing the presentation at home first.*

Students will share all aspects of their project with their classmates in a class presentation for a project grade beginning on **11/7/18**.
